

Deptford Jack in the Green: Route 1st May 2017

ARRIVE DESTINATION	DEPART ROUTE
START [opens 11.00] Dog and Bell , 116 Prince St SE8 3JD	From Dog & Bell: Benbow St, through Benbow and Oxenham flats to Gilbert House, Deptford Green, Stowage, Glaisher St, right at Ferranti Square. Cross the creek at the Swing Bridge. Continue along Norway St, left into Victoria Parade to Sail Loft.
12.30 Sail Loft , 11 Victoria Parade, SE10 9FR [Greg Meikle]	13.15 From Sail Loft: Continue along riverside walk (if windy, Creek Rd) to Cutty Sark Gardens.
13.30 LUNCH, MUSIC and DANCE STOP. Cutty Sark Gardens. No "official" pub here, but several nearby.	NO DRINKS from Gypsy Moth OUTSIDE PUB PERIMETER. NO COLLECTING at Cutty Sark Gardens or in Old Royal Naval College. From Cutty Sark Gardens: through Old Royal Naval College, via Cutty Sark Gates, Pepys Lawn, Fryers Walk, College Way, out at East Gate, Park Row, Old Woolwich Rd to Star and Garter.
14.30 Star and Garter , 60 Old Woolwich Rd, SE10 9NY [Keith]	15.15 From Star and Garter: go up Greenwich Park Street, cross Trafalgar Road, continue to Park Vista and Plume of Feathers
15.30 Plume of Feathers , 19 Park Vista , SE10 9LZ [Maeve]	16.15 From Plume of Feathers: Park Vista, through Park Row Gate, through Greenwich Park. No collecting in Park. Exit at St Mary's Gate, left down Nevada Street to Rose and Crown.
17.00 Rose and Crown , 1 Crooms Hill, SE10 8ER [Peter Clarke]	17.45 Please take care in the road outside the pub. From Rose and Crown: cross Crooms Hill, go along Burney Street, right into Royal Hill [NB: by the police station!], cross Greenwich South St, Ashburnham Grove to Ashburnham Arms.
18.00 Ashburnham Arms , 25 Ashburnham Grove, SE10 8UH [Pepina]	END

Throughout the day

This event relies on the goodwill of the local police and organisations such as the Greenwich Town Centre management, the Old Royal Naval College and the Royal Parks so please take note of the following guidelines:
